16-049 BUDGET AND FINANCE:

049.1 Financial Reports & Expense Listing

Chief Executive advised that a preliminary report from the Accountant indicates that Council is likely to be near break-even this financial year. He noted that a main cause was the decrease in Council's licence income of about \$50,000.

16-050 OPERATIONS AND STAFF REPORTS:

051.1 Activity Reports & Operations Reports (8.1)

Staff responded to general queries from Councillors related to topics reported in their activities and operations reports. Topics included:

- Praise for the new Ashburton Lakes access pamphlet,
- Hakataramea River works,
- Gravel extraction,
- Update on content of Fish and Game's submission to the RDR's consent applications. I.e. Fish and Game submitted in opposition on 3 points related to these applications:
 - 1) the additional 10 cumec take,
 - 2) the proposed fish barrier
 - 3) the proposed sediment flushing regime.

G Rooney declared he had a conflict of interest on the topic of RDR consents and advised that he took no part in the process of Fish and Game's submission.

16-051 DOC LIAISON:

- 051.1 D Winterburn updated and discussed with Council various works undertaken by DoC including:
 - Ranging issues related to the whitebait season.
 - Reports of large scale egg collection of braided river birds.
 - Minister of Conservation's announcement of aiming for NZ to be predator free by 2050.
 - Increased media attention on cattle in waterways.
 - Update on eradication of wilding pine. Advised that management areas identified for this year are the Godley, North Opuha, Hakatere, and Ashburton Basin.

051.2 Lower Waitaki Irrigation Scheme

G Rooney advised that the Lower Waitaki Irrigation Scheme (LWIS) have made the decision to put in a fish screen at Borton's Pond. However LWIS have expressed concern re DoC as LWIS will need DoC's permission to undertake works on their land. D Winterburn agreed to look at the design and advise of DoC's position.

16-052 CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S REPORT:

052.1 Licence Agreement Extension (9.1)

Chief Executive advised that the current agreement with Eyede for licencing services ends in December 2016 but contains a clause that a further two years may apply where both parties agree, which would mean that the agreement would run until 2nd December 2018. He reported that the current licence agreement has operated well over its 3-year period and recommends that the agreement be extended for the further two years.
